Roch Voisine's tour to stop in Moncton

Roch Voisine comes to Moncton on October 23 at 8 p.m. at the Capitol Theatre. This will be the third stop in his Canadian tour.

He will make his long-awaited return to the concert stage with the release of his fourth all-English album. With more than eight million records sold world-wide, Roch has developed into an international superstar. From humble beginnings in Saint-Basile, N.B., Roch has performed around the world to sold-out audiences in the hundreds of thousands.

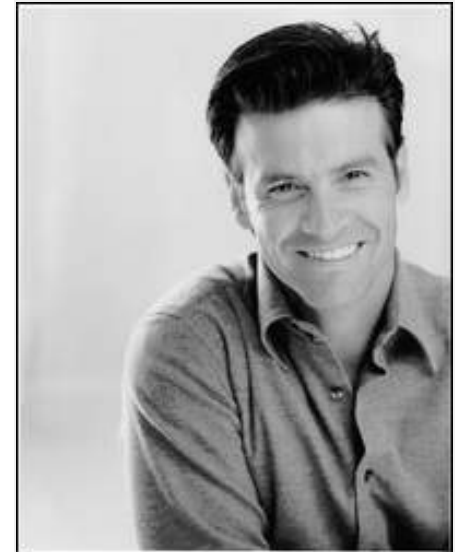
This tour marks a break from his past stadium-sized extravaganzas to bring Roch and his guitar with a couple of musical friends, to much smaller and up-close concert settings.

Roch's debut French album *Hélène*, released in 1989, has sold more than three million copies worldwide.

His first English album *I'll Always Be There* (co-written with David Foster in 1994) sold more than one million copies and garnered Roch a Juno for Best Male Vocalist that same year. In 1995 he received a second Juno for Best Seller, French Language Album for *Coup de Tete*. In 1996 he released his second English recording, *Kissing Rain* which quickly went platinum selling more than 193,000 copies.

In 2000 Roch released two separate Christmas albums; *L'Album de Noël* in French and *Christmas Is Calling* in English. Both Christmas recordings have each been certified gold.
