

Roch Voisine's tour to stop in Moncton

Roch Voisine comes to Moncton on October 23 at 8 p.m. at the Capitol Theatre. This will be the third stop in his Canadian tour.

He will make his long-awaited return to the concert stage with the release of his fourth all-English album. With more than eight million records sold world-wide, Roch has developed into an international superstar. From humble beginnings in Saint-Basile, N.B., Roch has performed around the world to sold-out audiences in the hundreds of thousands.

This tour marks a break from his past stadium-sized extravaganzas to bring Roch and his guitar with a couple of musical friends, to much smaller and upclose concert settings.

Roch's debut French album Hélène, released in 1989, has sold more than three million copies worldwide.

His first English album I'll Always Be There (co-written with David Foster in 1994) sold more than on million copies and garnered Roch a Juno for Best Male Vocalist that same year. In 1995 he received a second Juno for Best Seller, French Language Album for Coup de Tete. In 1996 he released his second English recording, Kissing Rain which quicklywent platinum selling more than 193,000 copies.

In 2000 Roch released two separate Christmas albums; L'Album de Noël in French and Christmas Is Calling in English. Both Christmas recordings have each been certified gold.
